No. 14 Nicolaes Jansen, baker, received a ground-brief for this plot from Director Stuvyesant and council, in 1656 (Liber HH, 2, 52, Albany), and here conducted a bake-shop, obtaining the small burgherright in 1657.—Rec. N. Am., VII: 152. He seems to have been a baker

at New Amsterdam as early as 1644, when he furnished the ship "Wapen van B	Rensselaers
Wijck" with breadVan Rensselaer Bowier MSS., 718, 721.
